PROJECT PURPOSE



CP4ALL project aims at optimizing Civil Protection preparedness activities in favor to vulnerable social groups – especially children – in case of emergencies, in particular right after the disaster happening, when citizens are often required to live in provisory camps, due to the temporary impossibility to stay at their houses. The project will train specific profiles that operate within Civil Protection and/or Red Cross organizations and which are competent for dealing with kids and other vulnerable people in the post disaster phase. These profiles will be trained for working in an international environment, so to be available during emergencies in all project Countries and abroad.

CONTEXT

CP4ALL has been developed to respond to a need expressed by various Civil Protection organizations and local authorities: the lack of specialized operators officially entitled to deal with kids in emergency situations.

Usually, in post-disaster phases, activities are supported by an high number of volunteers and operators. Their role is extremely important for children and families, being the first reference point and those who can spread positive feelings and self-confidence. The availability of trained operators able to lead and organize, also in an international context, the activity of volunteers in favor to kids and other vulnerable people will highly increase the effectiveness of these interventions, with a positive impact on the whole post-emergency management.



MAIN RESULTS

- Increased capacity of Civil Protection and Red Cross organizations to deal with kids and families in emergency situations.
- Effective management and valorization of volunteers' contribution.
- Enhanced capability to act and interact in an international environment, in case of emergency.
- Greater interactions among organizations belonging to different working backgrounds.
- Increased emergency reaction capacity, with particular attention to vulnerable social groups.
- Best practices identification and exchange at European level on project topics.
